One of the most beautiful operas ever composed in the Bel Canto era, a melodrama giocoso (playful melodrama) with unique narrative and musical concepts. In this production, the Italian stage director **Enzo Iorio** creates the image of a rustic world from his childhood, inspired by the movie "Riso Amaro" ("Bitter Rice") by **Guiseppe De Santis**.

A rural scene: sheaves of wheat, bales of hay, farmers, the neigh of the donkey, the din of farm machinery, the village simpleton, moonlight strolls and the smells of the farmland in deep summer. Images of hard work and love, that could be in any countryside anywhere in the world.
